Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope your children enjoyed a well-deserved half term break and that they've returned to school refreshed and excited about the half term ahead. This year we are going to hold our progress session after the reports have been issued. 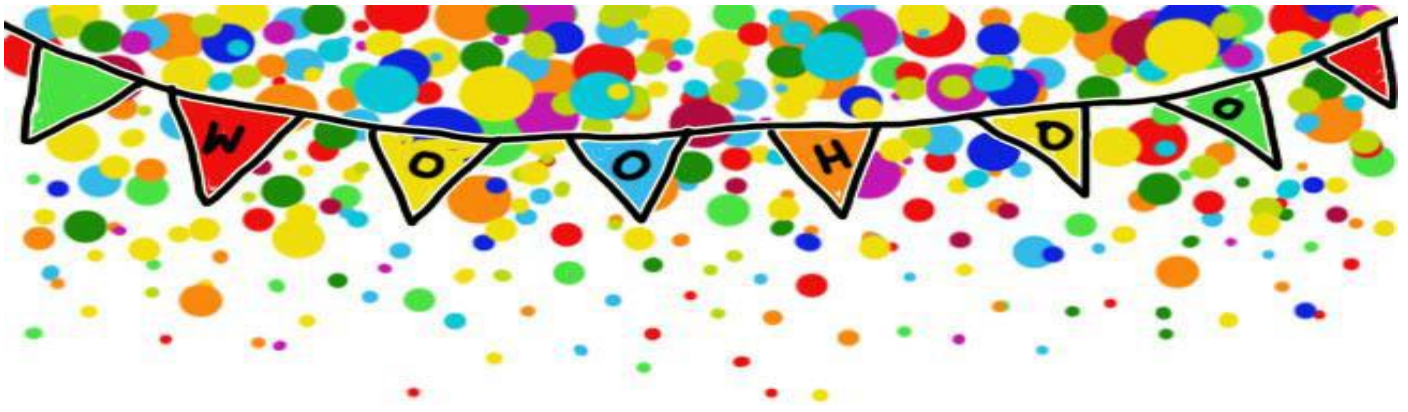
