If your application is received late your child may not be offered a place at their local primary school if all available places have been filled.

Gilmorton Chandler Primary School is an academy and as such is the admissions authority for this school. We will be working in co-ordination with Leicestershire Local Education Authority. We ask that if you wish your child to be considered for a school place at Gilmorton Chandler Primary School you complete a Governors Admissions Application Form and return this to the school office by the closing date of **22<sup>nd</sup> February 2019**.
