Dear Parents/Carers,

The half term ahead...

Please find below an overview of our operational development plan for the year ahead and key points from our strategic development plan for the longer term. Our short term key priorities are:

This year we will be continuing our emphasis on character education – developing character virtues. We are also hoping to retain our ActiveMark Gold status – our thanks go to Mr Thompson for all he does in organising a range of PE and sporting clubs and events.

In the longer term we wish to:

- Provide an extension housing a large multi-purpose area – this will also enable a room for after school child care provision, freeing the hall for further after school activities.
- Further develop local, national and international school links.
- Consider ways to raise additional funds for school resources and development.

First Time Admissions September 2019

Closing date for Applications to the Local Education Authority is 15th January 2019

If your child will be four years old before the 1st September 2019 and starting school for the first time the closing date for school place applications to the Local Education Authority is **15th January 2019**. Applications received after this date will be considered as late and will be dealt with after those received on time. If your application is received late your child may not be offered a place at their local primary school if all available places have been filled.

Gilmorton Chandler Primary School is an academy and as such is the admissions authority for this school. We will be working in co-ordination with Leicestershire Local Education Authority. We ask that if you wish your child to be considered for a school place at Gilmorton Chandler Primary School you complete a Governors Admissions Application Form and return this to the school office by the closing date of **22nd February 2019**.

Those parents of children already registered on Gilmorton Chandler Primary School database will have received instructions on how to apply for a school place.

[DIWALI DAY - WEDNESDAY 7th NOVEMBER](#)

Today we hosted a Diwali Day in school. We would like to thank Year 6 children who have brought the Hindu story of Rama & Sita alive through acting. The whole school started their day today in the school hall & listened intently as Rama's evil stepmother banished Rama and Sita to the forest. Thanks to Mr Chandler for the loan of his 'forest garden' the story continued outside. Sita had been taken by the 10 headed Demon King and Rama needed the children's help to find her. They followed a trail of jewels through the forest and met Hanuman, King of the monkey army, who offered to help. Hanuman led the children to the island of Lanka where Sita was being kept. Hanuman enlisted the children into his army (they all became monkeys) and they helped build a bridge for Rama to cross. Once Rama had crossed he fought the 10 headed Demon King with a golden arrow. The children cheered as Rama was crowned King. They then watched and followed the Diva back to their home town.

In classes, KS1 children thought more about the story and how Hindu's celebrate Diwali. KS2 classes compared the Hindu story of Rama & Sita with the Sikh story of Bandi Chhor looking at the story and its characters. They also listened to Daljit Chouhan, a Sikh visitor who explained how she celebrates Diwali and in particular the way the Langar (community kitchen) works inside the Gurdwara (Sikh place of worship). At Diwali time Sikhs would take an offering (such as a tin of potatoes/chickpeas or fruit) and this would be used to create a 'free' meal for anyone without distinction of religion, caste, gender, economic status or ethnicity. The meal is always vegetarian. We created our own Langar in our school hall. The children helped prepare a vegetarian curry with chapatti and fruit salad for their Langar. In the Langar (our school hall) everyone took off their shoes, covered their head, and ate together sitting on the floor, creating a Langar just like that in a Gurdwara with the values of equality being the same. It was lovely to see some of our local community too. All the children had a wonderful day experiencing Diwali celebrations.

Christmas Lunches 2018

(This is for the 4 days Monday 17th December to Friday 21st December excluding Monday 17th December when these classes will be visiting DeMontfort Theatre and will require a packed lunch on this day.) Payment for school lunches can be made online via SchoolMoney. If you do wish to pay by cash or cheque please send this into school in a sealed envelope clearly stating the amount enclosed and your child's name. Cheques should be made payable to 'Leicestershire County Council'.

Alternatively, if your child is in years 3 to 6 and they would like to join us only for the Christmas lunch on Wednesday 19th December 2018, the cost of one school lunch is £2.20 per child.
