Curriculum enrichment

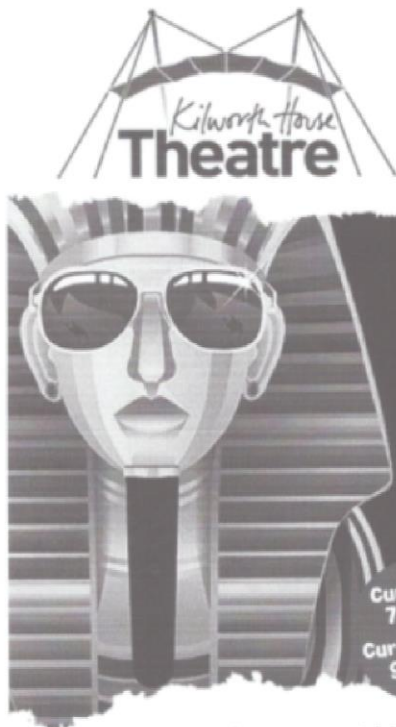

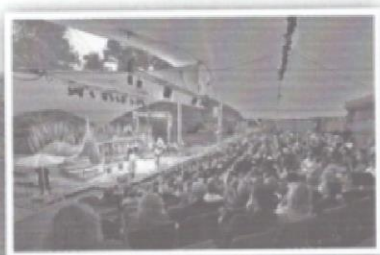
