First Time Admissions September 2020

Closing date for Applications to the Local Education Authority is 15th January 2020

If your child will be four years old before the 1st September 2020 and starting school for the first time the closing date for school place applications to the Local Education Authority is **15th January 2020**. Applications received after this date will be considered as late and will be dealt with after those received on time. If your application is received late your child may not be offered a place at their local primary school if all available places have been filled.

Gilmorton Chandler Primary School is an academy and as such is the admissions authority for this school. We will be working in co-ordination with Leicestershire Local Education Authority. We ask that if you wish your child to be considered for a school place at Gilmorton Chandler Primary School you complete a Governors Admissions Application Form and return this to the school office by the closing date of **28th February 2020**.

Those parents of children already registered on Gilmorton Chandler Primary School database will have received instructions on how to apply for a school place.

Payment for school lunches can be made online via SchoolMoney. Cheques should be made payable to 'Leicestershire County Council'.

Alternatively, if your child is in years 3 to 6 and they would like to join us only for the Christmas lunch on Wednesday 18th December 2019, the cost of one school lunch is £2.25 per child. This can also be paid through School Money or if you prefer to pay by cash or cheque please send this into school, in an envelope clearly marked with the name of your child and class on **Monday 16th December 2019.**
